### **“Elbow Valley West Unplugged”**

Dear Residents,

We all have waited a long time for this note. Our community has been through an incredible ordeal these past 10 years, but it is finally coming to an end. At the May 18<sup>th</sup> City of Calgary Inter-Government Affairs committee meeting, they unanimously voted to recommend to City Council that Elbow Valley West be added as a Service Area for sanitary waste water service, based on final technical reports from the City Water Services group. On May 28<sup>th</sup> Calgary City Council voted unanimously to approve the recommendation.

The City has agreed to service Elbow Valley West!

Operationalizing our connection is now out of the political process. Two steps remain:

- 1) the first is the completion of the updated Master Service Agreement between the City and Rocky View County (RVC). This is administrative. It does not go to City Council. The agreement has been worked on for the last year and is essentially completed.
- 2) Second is for the Operations Department at Rocky View County to work out the connection logistics/timing with the City of Calgary and detail a work crew to decommission the lift station, pull the plug and block flow to the pump & haul system. This work will only take a few days.

We will be meeting with RVC Operations the afternoon of May 31<sup>st</sup> and we'll provide further updates on connection logistics as they are known. The future cost of waste water is expected to be in the range of \$80/month.
